COVID 19 Update

Following CDC & Governor Baker's recommendations Phase 1 & Phase 2 will be a minimum of 3 weeks

Phase 3 will be a minimum of 6 weeks as of 5/15/2020

Phase 1

Play catch with child at Facility and volunteer work around the complex can be done

MAX of 25 people on each field

Umpires and Coaches need a mask at all times

CHILDREN only need them coming onto the Field and leaving the Field. During game play a child is NOT required to wear a mask

Phase 2 (possibly as of 6/8/2020)

30 minute window between games, practices, or any field use

NO Sharing bats, helmets, or catching gear

Parents have to social distance (6ft)

All persons should be wearing a mask unless they can be social distanced

Phase 3 (possibly as of 7/4/2020)

POSSIBILITY of a Fever check in the future IF necessary. IF parents deny then NO access to the Complex.

NO capacity in the Complex but masks, no sharing, social distancing, etc must all be followed.

Snack shack is approved to be OPEN because it is considered Take out

NO Tables or benches will be used or would have to be sanitized.

CDC will be keeping an eye on all facilities to make sure everyone is following the Guidelines.

Insurance is acceptable to proceed with rules and regulations of the Pandemic

Signs are being made for safety purposes

NO teams outside of MA are allowed to play games for Tournament reasons.

NO publicising practices or Games
